A Counterbalance forklift refers to a forklift along with a weight that counters the balance, enabling the load's weight to be spread equally across the arms of the forklift. Counterbalance forklifts are designed so the weight on the lift is counterbalanced by the weight behind the centre of gravity. The load is projected out from the equipment's front so it is visible to the driver of the forklift. This kind of forklift truck should just be used on stable, level ground or on a prepared surface.

Training is necessary for forklift drivers to know the right method to distribute the load evenly across the forklift arms. Trainees would learn how to raise and lower the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the forklift both forwards and backwards between 5 and 15 degrees. Trainees will be taught the RTITB standards required for safe forklift operation. Individuals training will likewise know the types of attachments for the arms of the forklift.

Kinds of Counterbalance Forklifts:

Walkie Pallet Trucks

The counterbalance forklift called the Walkie Pallet Truck is best suited for getting into areas that are both small and cramped. This particular lift is very maneuverable and capable of accessing practically any tight spot.

Walkie Stackers

The Walkie Stacker is a different forklift which varies slightly from the Walkie Pallet truck when it comes to its lift height. This particular equipment is designed to access tighter spaces and has extra lift capabilities for high stacking. Neither of the Walkie line of lifts can be ridden. The driver has to walk behind them.

Rider Pallet Trucks

Rider Pallet Trucks are designed to be ridden. These riding lifts are perfect for dock unloading and loading.

Wave Work Assist Vehicle

Sit Down Counter Balanced Trucks
