The price could be minimal (or free) when provided by occupational safety officers on job sites or through employment agencies.

Lift truck operators should be 18 years of age or over, in nearly all nations. Local industry bodies approve Loader Training programs and need operators to acquire a certificate before using this kind of heavy machines. A certificate is valid for four years in nearly all areas. Businesses which hire staff to drive forklift trucks can face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators could result in property damage and serious injury due to incorrect utilization of the machine. Training includes the right loading and driving methods. Employees must pass a written test in order to be certified. A company would normally assign a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new staff. A certified supervisor must have extensive training in lift truck safety and be trained as a trainer.
