Introduction

Warehouse operations which are efficient and orderly tend to be safer and more successful. It is necessary for the employee to move and store the merchandise throughout the facility in a timely and efficient manner. Because of the numerous activities involved within warehouse operations, workers in warehouse settings might be at greater risk for accidents than individuals who work in areas with more limited activities. Thus, companies prioritize warehouse safety.

Knowledge of possible warehouse dangers is key to preventing accidents. Always be alert to possible dangers and ways to lessen risks. Do whatever is necessary to avoid accidents.

General Hazards

Common kinds of hazard in a warehouse setting are falls, slips and trips. These accidents are usually caused when staff lose their balance or stumble over a thing that has not been put away properly. Placing or removing things from storage can result in a fumble or slip, possibly causing both worker and item to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when staff are moving materials on different types of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common danger is getting hit by falling items. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack stuff on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting methods are another common danger.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace equipment. Accidents can often be caused from the improper utilization of forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks. Warehouse tools, like skids, pallets, strapping and cutting tools, need to be used cautiously during loading, packing and unpacking.

Hazardous substances, flammable or combustible materials could pose danger while being stored inside a warehouse. Employees should know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers when working around dangerous materials.
