There are many different types of cranes in use, intended specially for specific applications. The smallest crane, the Jib crane, is meant to be utilized indoors. Tower cranes are the tallest type, used for building construction. To access tight spaces, mini-cranes are Utilized. Floating cranes are used oil rig construction and salvaging operations on water.

Crane operating procedure would be reviewed daily in the crane training course session. The implementation of correct overhead material handling procedures is covered in the course. Right training means longer equipment lifespan and less maintenance costs. The course instructs people participating in operating and inspection procedures focused on all application, such as correct rigging and slinging.
